Project Inspection & Empowerment Highlights



Safana LGA

Praised as the most extensive empowerment so far: 1,322 beneficiaries served with sewing, grinding, noodle machines, motorcycles, vehicles, power tillers, tricycles for PWDs, and significant cash distributions.













Kurfi LGA

Major LG empowerment benefiting 3,445 residents: vehicles for councillors, health vehicles, 1,000 bicycles, 1,000 pasta machines, 1,000 food packs / eggs / Indomie support, school supplies, and other tools. Zobe water extension promised; rehabilitation works and federal project inclusion discussed.

Mani LGA

Community engagement and commissioning of projects; scholarship programme announced by Mani LG; appeals for road rehabilitation (Mani-Dutsi, Duwan-Doro) and water support. Mani ranked 2nd in a two-year LG performance review.













Danmusa LGA

Flag-off distribution: 1,000 bags of rice, 100 motorcycles, 75 sewing machines, 11 vehicles, 75 grinding machines, POS machines (with #100k each) and other items. Governor linked empowerment to strategies for reducing insecurity and visited district heads.

Dandume LGA

LG support to 360 less-privileged men & women (#20,000 each); distribution of grinding and pumping machines, motorcycles, sewing machines, 3 vehicles and other livelihood items. Governor tied empowerment to poverty reduction.













Bakori LGA

Educational materials distribution (Bakori): 5,000 exercise books and 100 uniforms (philanthropic support).

Jargaba Primary Health Facility commissioned (maternity, staff quarters, equipment) and 110 solar streetlights flagged off for local wards.

SSA Ibrahim Kabir Masari's empowerment launch (\\$300,000 each to 1,000 beneficiaries)

Malumfashi LGA

Flag-off of a LG-funded mass empowerment to 1,859 beneficiaries (total value $\approx \$176,434,000$). Items: 6 cars, 21 motorcycles, 122 sewing machines, 200 flour mills, 200 POS (each loaded with \$100,000), cash grants (\$20k to 600 traders; \$30k to 1,000 beneficiaries), food support and more. Governor stressed LG autonomy and transparency.



Kafur LGA

LG-funded empowerment: 600 bags of cement, 25 motorcycles, 50 sewing machines, 4 vehicles, 100 grinding machines; LG provided ~\#20 million direct

Musawa LGA

Major grassroots empowerment: cash grants across many categories (e.g., #100,000 x 175 youths/women; multiple groups received #50,000 each), vehicles, 50 motorcycles, 110 grinding + 110 pepper mills, irrigation tools, fertilizers and water-pumping machines. Governor praised the LG chairman and met traditional leaders.













Matazu LGA

Distribution of sewing machines, irrigation & grinding machines, flour and other livelihood tools. Agricultural Mechanisation Centre commissioned; Governor ordered urgent upgrade of the Urban Water Supply while awaiting Zobe Dam extension.

Batsari LGA

Approval of five new secondary schools for Batsari & Wagini; 2.3 km road groundwork performed; foundation stone laid for Dr. Dikko Radda Cassava Gari Processing Centre (KASEDA initiative) — aimed at processing cassava, creating jobs and reducing post-harvest losses. Farmer support through local blending plant announced.

Kankara LGA

LG/federal constituency empowerment: vehicles, Hijet vans, motorcycles, grinding/sewing machines, POS, exercise books and other items; consultations on road and dam upgrades; praise for improved security.













Daura LGA

Inauguration of the 13.5 km Daura Western Bypass (includes 11.3 km link + 3 km dual carriageway). Emir named the road after Governor Radda; coordination for palace gate reconstruction and compensation discussed.

Separate Daura item: Speaker's Special Scholarship praised — #32,797,320 disbursed to 662 students across 25 institutions; Daura LG commissioned chairman's office/council chambers; 636 beneficiaries empowered locally; Federal upgrade of Daura Medical Centre announced.

Funtua LGA

LG support to 360 less-privileged men & women (#20,000 each); distribution of grinding and pumping machines, motorcycles, sewing machines, 3 vehicles and other livelihood items. Governor tied empowerment to poverty reduction.











Sabuwa LGA

Flag-off of 27.642 km Sabuwa-Tashar Bawa-Rafin Iwa road (contract sum #18.5bn, Fullman Nigeria Ltd, 18-month programme). Government paid 40% advance; compensation and monitoring emphasized.

Also: philanthropist-funded empowerment in Sabuwa -1,500 women to receive grants; distribution of 10,000 exercise books, 1,000 uniforms, 40 bicycles, 300 JAMB forms, machines (grinding, maize-shelling, sewing) and other support.

Mashi LGA

Large empowerment: motorcycles, 200 bags of assorted grains, sewing & grinding machines, wheelchairs, barbering kits, vehicles and other support. Governor commended local initiatives and acceptance of new political decampees noted.











Dutsi LGA

Flag-off: 3.5 km township road and 17 km feeder road; focus on rural connectivity and promise to work on potable water solutions. Stakeholder consultations and palace visits carried out.

Ingawa LGA

Launched Ingawa Fellowship Forum Scholarship Scheme supporting 204 undergraduates (#4.4 million total: 200×#20,000, 4×#100,000); commissioned #30 million X-ray machine at Ingawa General Hospital; ongoing road projects; engaged stakeholders and traditional leaders to strengthen grassroots governance.

Multi-million-naira empowerment rollout featuring motor cars, motorcycles, tricycles, sewing machines, wheelchairs, maternity beds, cement, and roofing zinc, targeting families, small businesses, and persons with disabilities. Programme boosts livelihoods, supports entrepreneurs, and strengthens community infrastructure.

GOVERNOR RADDA THANKS KATSINA RESIDENTS FOR MASSIVE TURNOUT DURING STATEWIDE TOUR



Katsina State Governor, Malam Dikko Umaru Radda, has expressed profound gratitude to the people of Katsina State for their overwhelming support and participation during his historic nine-day statewide tour of all 34 local government areas.

The governor thanked residents for trooping out en masse to receive him, engage in constructive dialogue, and demonstrate their commitment to the state's development.

The governor also appreciated stakeholders, party executives, and even opposition parties for believing in his administration's "Building Your Future" agenda.

"Development transcends political affiliations. I am encouraged by the support from across party lines, which shows that when it comes to Katsina's progress, we are all one family," he said.

Batagarawa LGA

Governor Radda's visit to Batagarawa LGA featured key achievements, including support for traditional rulers with assured palace rehabilitation, consideration of major road construction requests, and the supervision of a large empowerment programme that distributed 12 cars, 30 motorcycles, 100 sewing machines, 100 grain-processing machines, 100 grinding machines, 50 spaghetti machines, alongside food items and livestock such as 50 bags of flour, 300 crates of eggs, 500 cartons of Indomie, 100 bags of sugar, 100 boxes of milk, 100 goats, and 100 assistance packages. He also commissioned several community development projects executed by the LG Chairman.

















Baure LGA

Governor Radda's visit highlighted ongoing and upcoming infrastructure works, education support and school supplies, healthcare delivery improvements, water supply expansion, and agricultural & local economic empowerment through grants for small businesses and vulnerable households; the visit also included stakeholder meetings with traditional rulers, youth, and women, and welcomed decampees back to the APC.
